EURAMA (the Euro – Asian Mastology Association) mission is to promote the transfer of breast knowledge and know – how to all countries of the world, and to combat the disease more effectively. It aims to alert doctors and women to the growing global problem of breast cancer (2 million new cases per year expected in 2020), otherwise technology transfer will be ineffective, for example intraoperative radiotherapy.

We believe that the experience accumulated in Western countries – where cancer has been common for over a century and where mortality is now declining – could be useful in Eastern world. We therefore feel that collaboration between cancer experts would be very useful and have taken the initiative of founding the Euro-Asian Society for Breast Diseases (EURAMA).

EURAMA was created in 2010 and it became important. We started in 2011 with the General Assembly in Istanbul (Turkey).

In September, 2012 was been the first Scientific Congress in Moscow with a big success: 579 registered from 25 different countries, representatives of Russian Government and International diplomats. (all.1)

A first big event for the women with breast cancer during the Congress (EURAMA Woman).

The Third EURAMA Congress will take place in Jordan, Amman on 9th-11th October 2013. The Congress will be organised with the King Hussein Cancer Center. (all.2)

This important event will kick start EURAMA's mission in the Middle East.

The next Eurama Congress will be in Qatar and India in 2014, in China in 2015, in Thailand in 2016.
